

## EXAMPLE ON HOW TO FILL OUT THE “BRACKET SHEET”

This example illustrates how to properly fill out the bracket for a 27 person tournament.

Registration closed with 27 names on the sign-up list. We cut out #'s 1-27 off of the enclosed sheet, folded them, and put them in a hat. Here are the 27 players with their # that they drew out of the hat.

1. Bob
2. Sally
3. Mike
4. Fred
5. George
6. Gina
7. Eric
8. Steve
9. Jason
10. Heather
11. Derek
12. Pete
13. Tom
14. Ken
15. Scott
16. Rob
17. Mitch
18. Gene
19. Dori
20. Don
21. Alice
22. Harry
23. Dawn
24. Amy
25. Todd
26. Kristi
27. Brook

Here are the instructions from sheet on how to fill out the bracket;

*27 Players - Player's #1-5 start in Round 3 (fill in first), Player's #6-27 fill-in spot #'s 11-32 in Round 2*

As you can see from the example, Player's #1-5 Start in Round 3 (Bob, Sally, Mike, Fred, & George) and everyone else starts in Round 2. Player #6 (Gina) would be written in spot # 11 in Round 2, Player #7 (Eric) would be written in spot # 12 in Round 2, etc.

As the matches complete, simply advance the winners until you have a champion.
